



2010 SALE RULES

SALE DATE: Saturday, April 17th, 2010

LOCATION: Puyallup Fairgrounds, Puyallup, WA

TIME: 10:30 AM Starting with the viewing of sale cattle at 10:00 am

CONSIGNORS: All Washington, Oregon, California, Idaho and Nevada breeders are invited to consign to this sale. All Hereford consignors will be charged the annual dues for Washington State Hereford Association if they are not members (\$40.00). All Angus consignors will be charged the annual dues for the Western Washington Angus Association if they are not members (\$15.00). Limousin, Simmental & All Other "guest" consignors will be charged an additional fee of \$35.00 in lieu of a membership fee.

ENTRY FEE: \$100.00 per head for bulls, heifers, cows and cow-calf pairs. \$50.00 per head for steers. **Entries close February 1st, 2010.** Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the sale management but not after catalog has gone to print. Late entry fee for all animals is \$125.00 per head. Late entries, if accepted, cannot be guaranteed publication in catalog. All Entry fees are non-refundable.

REGISTRATION AND ELIGIBILITY: All females and bulls must have their appropriate, breed respective registration papers to be sold. ***Originals must be given to the sale management after you have arrived at the Puyallup Fairgrounds.*** Sale cattle may arrive Wednesday April 14th between the hours of 3:00-8:00pm, but must arrive no later than Thursday April 15th between the hours of 9:00-11:00am. No animal will sell unless the signed registration papers are in the hands of the sale management prior to the sale. **Please send in a copy of the registration with your consignment paperwork.** Registration papers are not required for steers but birthdates, name, sire, and dam are appreciated for catalog information. Steers must meet the appropriate criteria.

Females bred A.I. and due to calve after sale date may, at the seller's discretion, be sold with or without an A. I. certificate necessary for registration of the unborn calf. Decision of the seller shall be noted in the catalog and announced prior to sale.

REGISTRATION PAPERS AND TATTOOS WILL BE VERIFIED. Tattoos must match those recorded on registration papers and must be legible. Animals not in compliance, as determined by the sale committee, will be eliminated from the sale. **Please check tattoos before leaving home!**

ENTRIES MUST COMPLY WITH ALL RULES TO BE ACCEPTED. AFTER ENTRY IS ACCEPTED, THERE WILL BE NO REFUND OF THE ENTRY FEE.

HEAD COUNT: The sale management will accept a minimum of 20 head of cattle. There is no preset limit to the number of cattle any consignor may consign. Each consignor shall establish a sale entry priority for their consignments. Priority will be indicated by the order of listing on the entry form.

General Rules

You WILL NOT be required to have a vet inspection to get into the SALE because that will be done by the Fair vet upon arrival on the fairgrounds UNLESS you have a bred female, which will require a certificate of pregnancy from a veterinarian, or over 18 months of age (see note below) then you need a statement of ability to breed.

FEMALES - AGE/BREEDING INFORMATION: Maximum of five years of age for female consignments. Females must be guaranteed open, A.I. bred, pasture exposed, or safe with calf. All females 24 months of age or

greater, must be bred or have calf at side, or both. Any female 18 months or older must be palpated by a veterinarian and indicated by the veterinarian that the animal is, in his professional opinion, bred or breed able. Complete breeding information must be submitted with entry forms.

BULLS: Maximum age of 30 months for bull consignments. All bulls over 12 months of age **must be semen tested**, and the certificate must be turned into the sale management by sale day. All bulls must be halter broke and have a nose lead.

- All animals must be healthy, sound, and in good breeding condition.
- No Angus entries will be accepted that have known carriers of class one genetic defects in the printed pedigree. Individuals tested clean and so verified by the American Angus Association will be accepted. The sale management based upon American Angus Association records will make this determination at the time of entry. Entries considered having non-traditional blood factors or with such animals in their pedigrees, as determined by the American Angus Association, will be footnoted as such.
- All animals should be BVD tested.
- **All animals must be halter broke.** Every animal must be tied with a rope halter and neck rope, the halter will go with the animal.
- Consignors are urged to assist in the delivery of the sale cattle at the buyer's risk. No consignor may leave the sale until shipping arrangements are confirmed with the sale management. Consignors may be subject to an additional charted if this rule is disregarded.
- Substitutions may be made any time prior to the date of sale. It shall be the consignors responsibility to furnish handouts and breeding information on the substitutions. All rules shall remain in effect for cattle substituted.
- Cattle must be eligible to pass necessary health tests to enter any state into which they may sell, or seller still owns the animal. Seller will maintain the animal, making the necessary tests at his cost and assist in arranging shipping animals needing additional tests. Consignors should note that many states will not accept non-vaccinated females, so any female over 4 months of age must be bangs vaccinated.
- **INDIVIDUAL HEALTH PAPERS ARE REQUIRED ON EACH OUT OF STATE ENTERED LOT.**
- Washington State Cattle may come to the sale on a transportation slip, but cattle from outside WA must have brand inspection and health papers. The brand inspector will be available on sale day to provide brand papers to the new owners.
- All cattle shall be sold to the highest bidder. Consignors will be permitted one bid for each animal consigned. In the event two or more bidders claim the same bid the auctioneer shall be the sole arbiter.
- Commission on the No-Sale animals will be charged based on the consignor's floor price and calculated on the same commission percentage as animals that are sold.
- Sifted cattle and No-Sale animals sold privately on the sale grounds will be charged the same commission on the sale price as those sold through the sale. Floors will be asked for prior to the sale.
- "No sale" animals are the responsibility of the consignor following the sale.
- **All cattle will be evaluated by appointed personnel and sale management. Sifting will be done on the basis of disposition, soundness, conformation, and quality.**
- **Consignors must bring their own grain and hay for their animals, bedding will be furnished. This facility is open to the general public so your animals should be displayed as such. Appropriate displays are encouraged and proper care of your animals and area is mandatory. This event is being held in conjunction with the Northwest Junior Livestock show. NO alcohol is permitted on the grounds you will be stalled in the same barn as the youth exhibiting their beef animals.**
- **LOT # CARDS WILL BE PROVIDED FOR SALE ANIMALS TO HANG UP WITH YOUR STALL CARDS.**

Sale Day – Sale cattle must be ready for viewing at 10:00am and the Washington State All Breed Classic will begin at 10:30 am.

Floor price will be determined by seller and communicated to auctioneer prior to sale. Sellers will pay full commission on the floor price submitted if the animal does not sell. It is the responsibility of sellers to notify the auctioneer if they will accept a lower bid when they are in the sale ring.
